All application materials must be typed and returned in one package by mail, including:

- 1) Completed application form.
- 2) A personal essay explaining who you are, your passion for the vocal art, and how you plan to pursue your musical education.
- 3) Three recommendations total: one from your high school choral director, and two from other adults (not parents), including the private voice teacher (if applicable).
- 4) A Letter of Acceptance into a school of music with a concentration in vocal music performance or music education.
- 5) Current high school transcript.

**Finalists for the scholarship will be scheduled for an interview with a panel of ACDA members during the Vermont All State weekend on May 5-7, 2011**

**Finalists for the scholarship will be scheduled for an interview with a panel of ACDA members during the Vermont All State weekend on May 5-7, 2011 at B.F.A. St. Albans.**
